May 2, 2018

The regular May meeting of the Philmont Library Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:05 PM by President Nathaniel Drake. Also present were Vice President Dave Bolevice, Secretary Faith Benson, Treasurer Jason Kenny, Daniel Starr, Director Tobi Farley, and visitor Sharon Davis.

<u>Visitors in Attendance</u>: Sharon Davis, a Columbia County representative of the Mid-Hudson Library System (MHLS) and a member of the New York State Library System's Incentives Committee, whose contributions included:

- 1) Recognition of the Library's record of having been designated a Five-Star Library for 5 years, with the note that only 5 of the 66 libraries in the MHLS were awarded from 1 to 5 stars in 2017
- 2) MHLS workshops on grant applications offered to library directors

A MOTION to accept the April 2018 minutes was made by Bolevice, seconded by Drake, and unanimously approved.

Correspondence was presented by Benson and discussed.

The <u>Treasurer's Report</u> was presented by Kenny. The Library's Operating Fund currently totals \$30,734.95. Discussion included:

- 1) Possible investment strategies to be investigated by Kenny
- 2) Receipt of the semi-annual monetary support from the Town of Claverack

The Director's Report was presented by Farley. Topics discussed included:

- 1) Building repairs needed
- 2) Inappropriate, disruptive behavior by unsupervised youth on Library grounds: Farley will pursue this with the Philmont Chief of Police.
- 3) The Summer Reading Program, to be led by Hudson teacher Alicia McCagg
- 4) Annual purchase of a program by Library Aware that Farley uses to create Library fliers
- 5) The Columbia County Library Association's museum pass reservation system
- 6) Circulation: checkouts, check-ins, renewals, and OverDrive (e-books and e-audio books)
- 7) A Petty Cash balance of \$48.79

Old Business:

- 1) Plans for "Book It!", the 5K run/walk race on June 10 to support the Philmont Public and the Claverack Free Libraries
- 2) Revisions to the Library's Charter having been sent to NYS through the MHLS
- 3) The Memorandum of Understanding between the Library and the Friends of the Library
- 4) The Library's By-laws: A MOTION was made by Bolevice, seconded by Starr, and unanimously approved that the Board approve the Philmont Public Library By-laws as discussed and revised during the May 2, 2018, meeting.
- 5) Revisions and additions to Library policies: Drake appointed an ad-hoc Policy Committee made up of Drake, Farley, and Benson.

A MOTION to adjourn was made by Starr, seconded by Bolevice, and unanimously approved at 8:45 PM.

The next meeting of the Library Board will be held at 7:00 on Wednesday, June 6, 2018.
