# Philmont Public Library

The regular January meeting of the Philmont Public Library Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:02 PM by President Faith Benson. Also present were Vice President Dave Bolevice, Secretary Rain Whittaker, Treasurer Jason Kenny, Director Tobi Farley, and Villiage Liaison Representive Barbara Sagal.

**Public Comment:** Gatter made suggestions regarding the proposed library addition, including what steps are needed to begin the preliminary work for the NYS grant.

<u>Minutes</u>: A MOTION to accept the December 2019 minutes was made by Benson, seconded by Kenny, and unanimously approved.

<u>Correspondence</u>: The <u>Register Star</u> and <u>Columbia Paper</u> were contacted and notified of ongoing board and policy meetings. Thank you letters were written.

**President's Report**: was presented by Benson.

- 7. Reaching out to the Co-op for possible collaboration of their cooking courses for local teens and their families

- 1. Building and Grounds: Thanks to Patrick Farley for replacing 2 ballasts in the lights.
- 2. Christmas Ornament Workshop was a success with over 55 people attending both the children's and adult workshops.
- 3. The Philmont Memory Project for 2019 is complete. We had nearly 20 stories published in Vol. 1 which is available at the library to borrow or purchase. We are starting to collect memories for Vol. 2 in 2020.
- 4. 30 people were in attendance for the movie <u>Abominable</u>, with sandwiches from McNan's (sponsored by The Friends of the Library).
- 5. The Columbia Land Conservancy will be presenting an afterschool program on Mondays from 3:30-5:00PM beginning on Jan. 13th. The Rotary Club is sponsoring the snacks for this program.
- 6. The Fine Free announcement was made in the papers, online and on the library website. We have been receiving many positive comments.
- 7. Soup Sales begin this month on Wednesdays from 4-5:30 PM
